02. PROPOSITION

Watson & Gabb provide an extensive collection of panels suitable for most residential and commercial applications, providing flexibility in finishes and specification.

03. PREREQUISITES

04. THE PROCESS

As you might expect, custom projects are time-consuming, involve a lot of communication, and are accompanied by a different pricing structure and lead time. All our panels are produced via a combination of hand and state-of-the-art technology, and with custom the process usually follows the below structure:

- 1. We require the client to provide as much initial information on likely project as possible including initial brief, in-situ photos, documentation, budget and time frames. More information early enough assists in the process greatly.
- 2. Initial design brief meeting with Client/Designer and the Watson & Gabb Design Team (via Zoom or in person)
- 3. Agree and Issue Return Brief and Design Fee.
- 4. Client Engagement/Agreement.
- 5. Reconnaissance.
- 6. Site Visit, if required, to check, liaise with contractors, client, architect, interior designer as required.
- 7. Presentation of Initial Concepts.
- 8. Revisions and concept design development.
- 9. Final revisions and concept presentation.
- 10. New moulds created as required.
- 11. Production.
- 12. Shipping & Delivery.

Please Note: We do not ordinarily offer installation, but we are open to discussing unique requirements.



05. TIMELINES

Shop drawings generally take between 1 - 4 weeks depending on scope of project.

Custom fabrication usually takes between 8 - 16 weeks, dependent on material availability, production schedules. Patience is a virtue here as all projects are unique, however we do try very hard to work within your deadlines — anything is possible!

06. RATES


How long is a piece of string?
